

Village Walk Report 15.5.16

The walking group from the villages of Abberton & Langenhoe consisted of twenty adults and three dogs on leads. They had met at Langenhoe village hall and received an introductory talk from the leader Gordon Davis. Information about Health & Safety and the wearing of high visibility jackets by the leader and the backmarker being essential, the walkers were expected to keep between the two members wearing luminous jackets.

The group drove and parked near Fingringhoe Church for the three-mile route and walked via South Green Farm, Jagger's, Lower Brickhouse Farm and back to the church. In brilliant sunshine, the leader pointed out Arlesford, Brightlingsea Church, Point Clear and a little further on but out of sight Jaywick and Clacton. The leader also indicated where farmers had left 6-metre conservation grass headlands to attract wildlife. The group were also interested in the different finishes to the various properties in Fingringhoe on the return leg to their cars.

As usual the village tea had been arranged by Derek and Ena Ingram and the central persons in the organisation of the afternoon being Margaret Clouter, Michael Lock and
