

REPORT OF 31ST VILLAGE WALK

Sixteen adults, three children from the same family including twins Jenson and Jasmine plus their cousin Alicia all from Witham and three dogs on leads attended the 31st village walk sponsored by the Abberton & Langenhoe Parish Council. The weather was kind and the walkers drove to and parked at Fingringhoe Church for a circular country route of about 2.8 miles. Under the leadership of Gordon Davis the walkers went up Furneaux Lane, towards South Green Farm to obtain magnificent views of the Colne Estuary at high tide. The group then retraced their steps, followed a route which passed 'Jaggers', used the bridleway adjoining Essex Wildlife Nature Reserve round to Holmwood Farm and finally back to Fingringhoe Church and then onto Abberton & Langenhoe village hall for another social tea organised by Derek and Ena Ingham. This was a first-time experience for many of the walkers who have all pledged their enthusiasm for future walks.
