Following a survey in 2010, the Parish Council secured funding of £4783.00 from Essex County Council's Community Initiatives fund for a basket goal. On Friday 16th September 2011, the basketgoal was installed and is being put to good use.

A working party has been set up and we are liaising with two skate park companies regarding design ideas. At a recent council surgery, villagers requested road safety signs and a second dog waste bin. The Parish Council are pleased to report that Highways have agreed to install the road signs and the Parish Council have purchased a second bin.

The road signs should be installed by the end of the year and the dog bin is with the contractor for installation. The Parish Council were also successful in securing funding from Cory Environmental Trust in Rochford for two benches that will be sited on the sea wall.

Memorial Bench
