Changes to Recycling Centres

From 31 October 2016 business waste is not accepted at Essex Recycling Centres.

To prevent business waste disposal and improve the way recycling centres deal with household waste, from 31 October 2016, the centres will no longer accept:

- soil
- hardcore
- plasterboard
- bathroom ceramics, including sinks, toilets and baths, and any tiles
- fitted kitchen units and worktops
- UPVC or wooden doors or window frames.

And will no longer give access to:

- trucks
- vans, including car-derived vans
- pick-ups
- any towed trailer with more than one axle.
