

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Lower Road, Borely)(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of Lower Road, in the Parishes of Borely and Foxearth in the District of Braintree, In its entirety from its junction Halstead Road, south to its junction with School Road.

The closure is scheduled to commence on 7 November 2016 for two days or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while verge repairs are undertaken.

The alternative route will be via School Road, Hall Road, Belchamp Walter Road, Temple End, Mill Road, School Street, Halstead Road, and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The Order will come into effect on 7 November 2016 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
