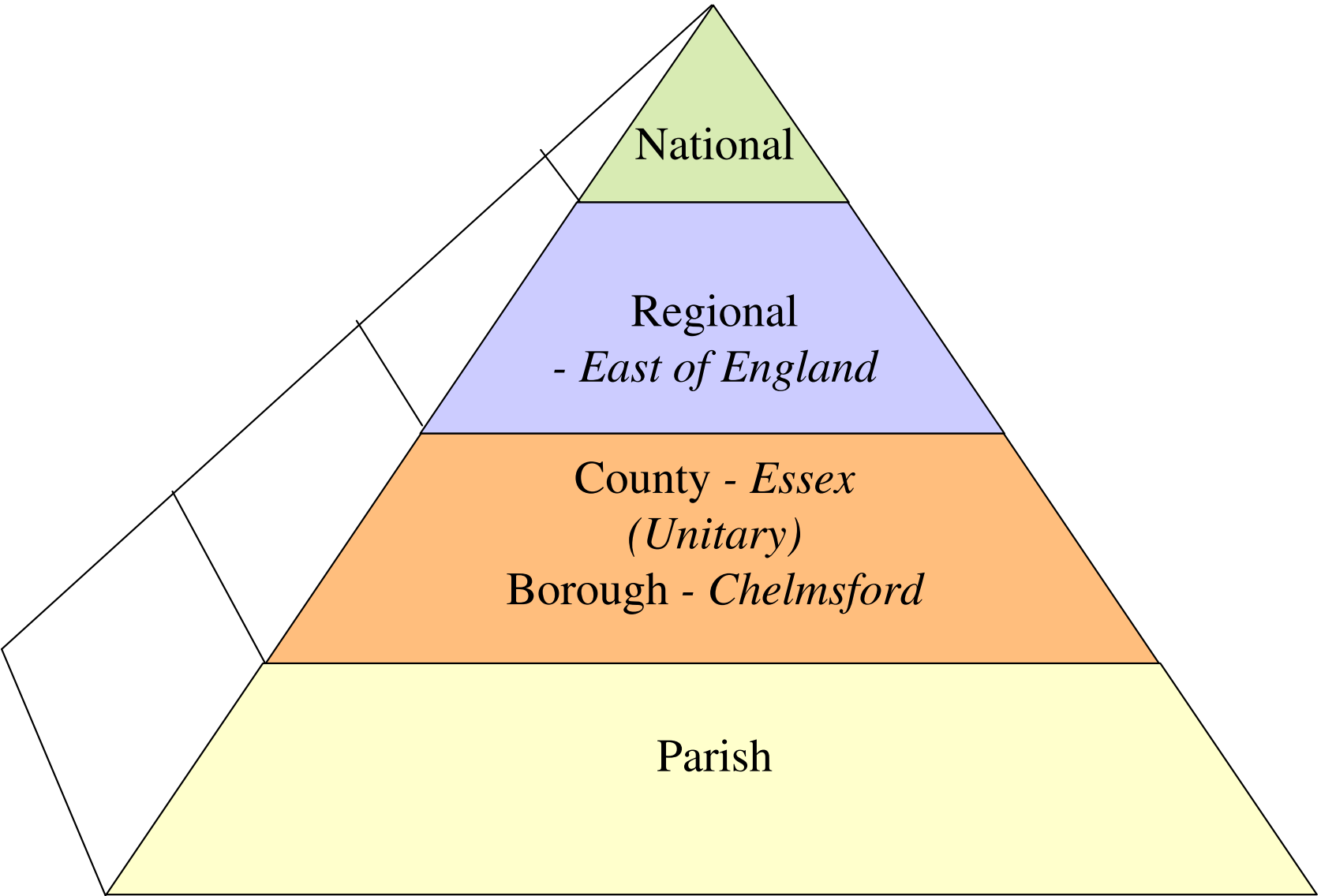

# Parish plans are part of the planning pyramid



# There are two main planning strands ...

- **Land use and development strategy**
  - Housing. How many, where, what type
  - Industry. What and where
  - Leisure and areas not developed. Green belt/spaces

## Local version – Village Design Statements

- **Community strategy**
  - Transport
  - Safety & security
  - Environment
  - Health
  - Education and personal development
  - Culture & leisure (sport, arts, heritage)

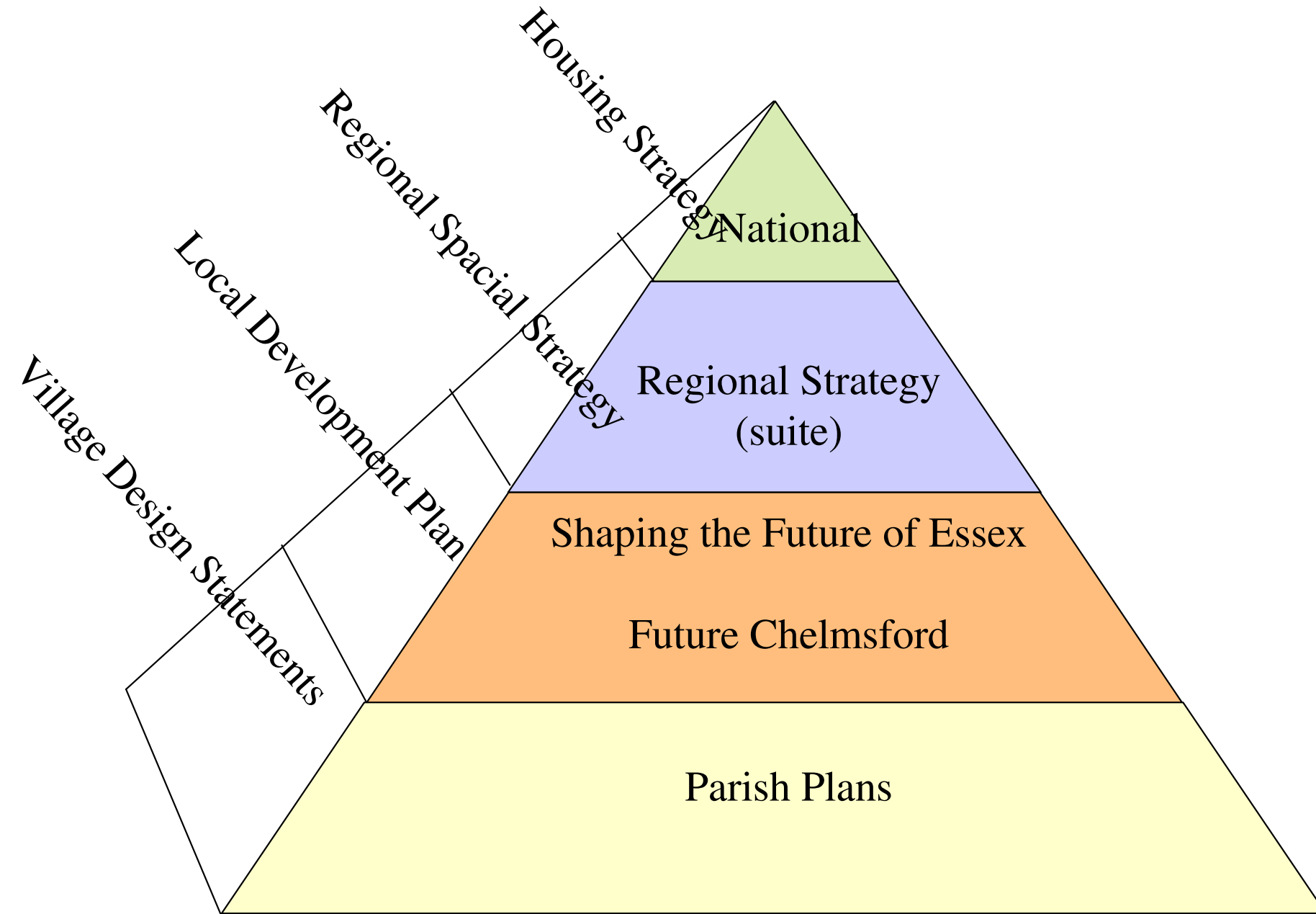
## Local version – Parish Plan

*Both of these strands have their own pyramids of strategies and plans*

*Nothing can be seen in isolation – it just another face of the same pyramid*

**... which are mutually dependent**

## **Essex 2004-2024**

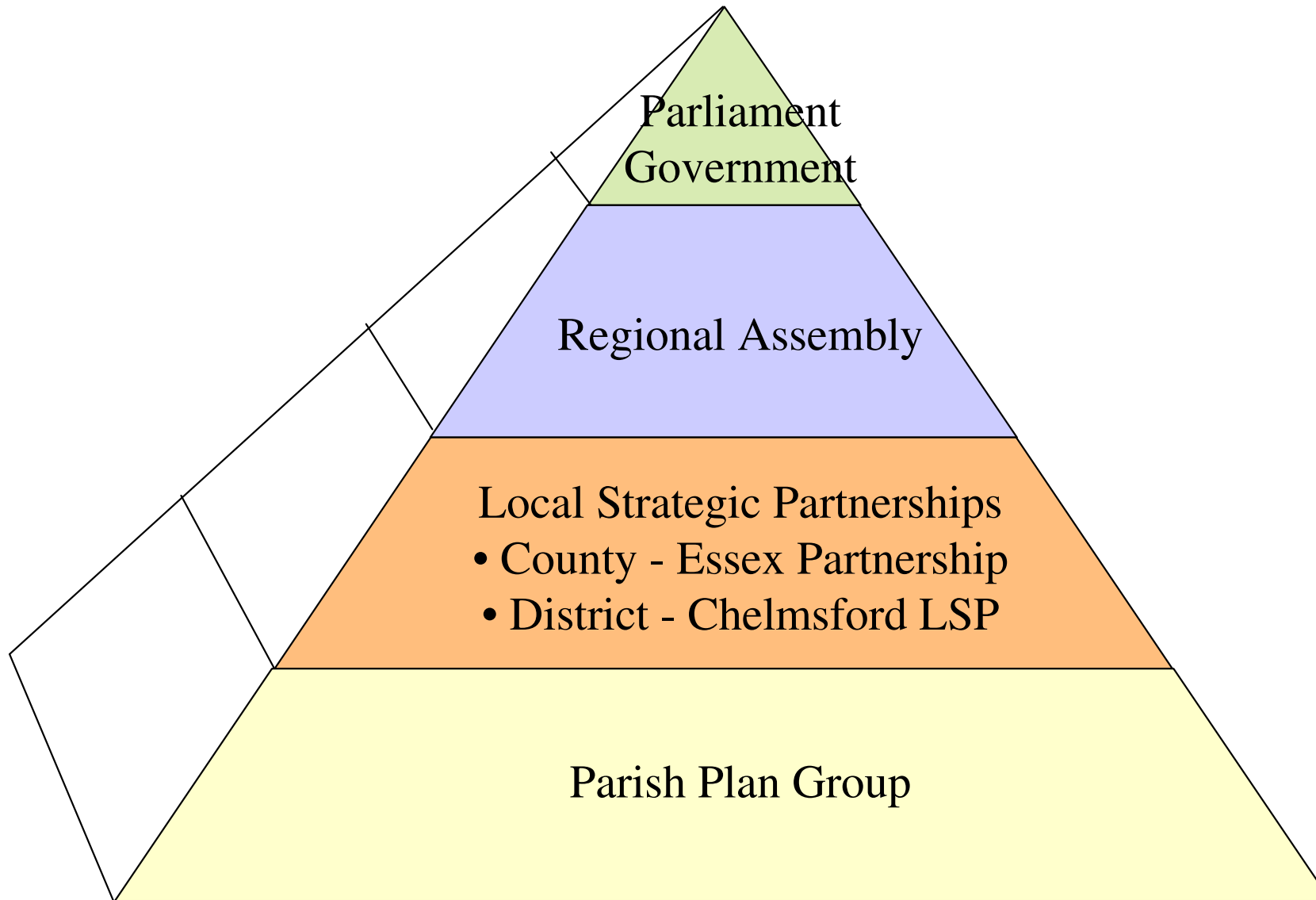
- *Being part of a community*

- Show how the your actions fit with the themes and actions plan
- Ensure theme leads on LSP Board are aware of the relevant Parish Plan actions
