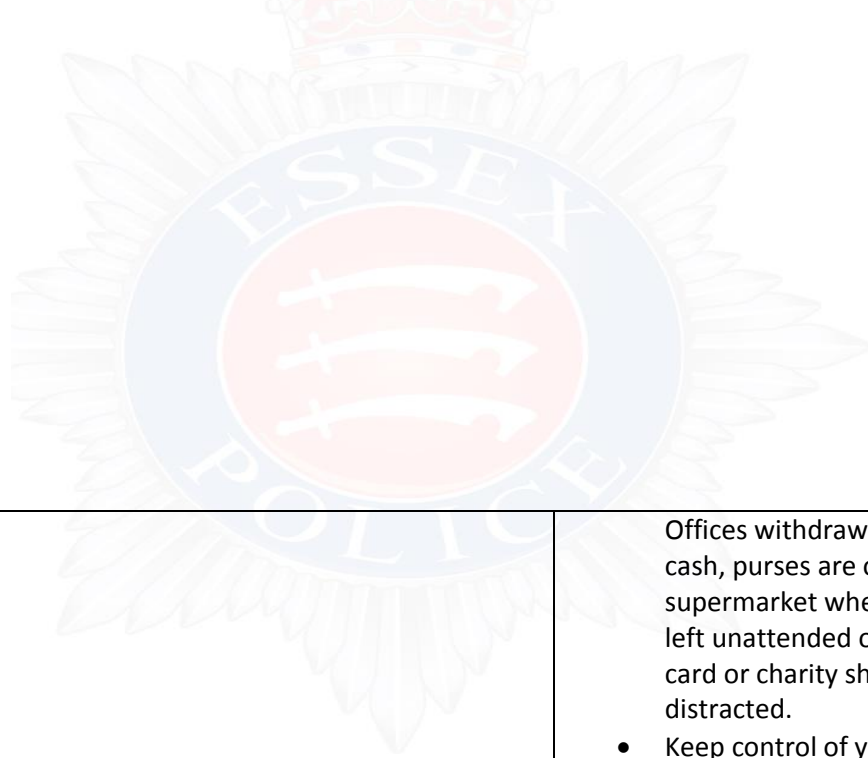

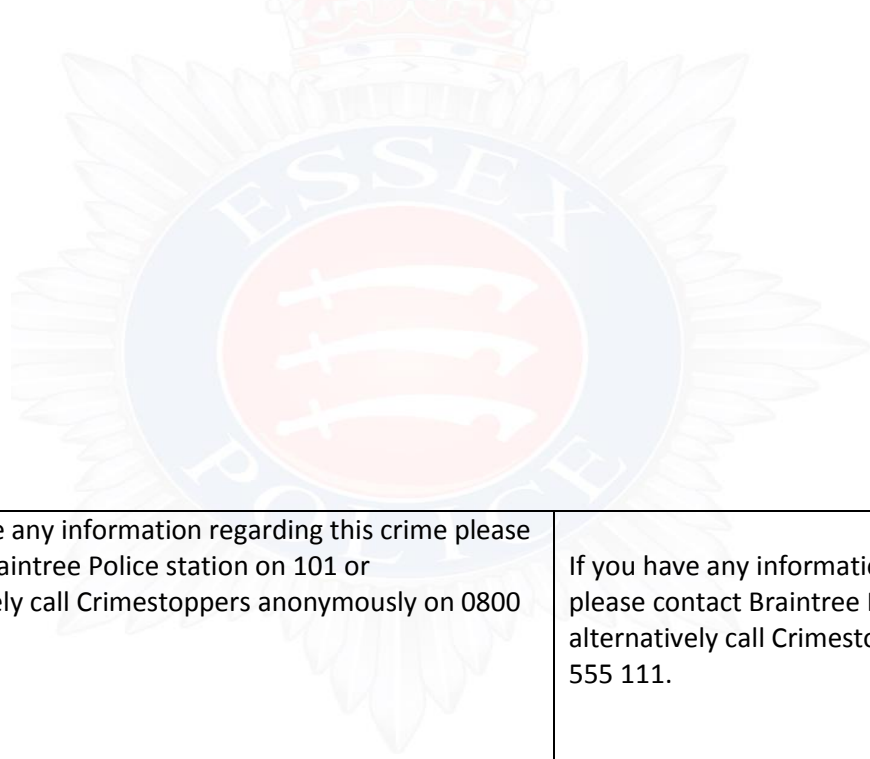

- Register your valuables at www.immobilise.com. It's free and takes just a few minutes and, if your valuables are stolen, it will allow you to tell the police, your insurer and the second-hand trade to assist in recovering your property and catch the thief.
- Consider purchasing a 24-hour segment timer for under £5. These timers can be used with a lamp, radio or TV to give the impression that someone is at home. Remember to use an energy-efficient light bulb.
