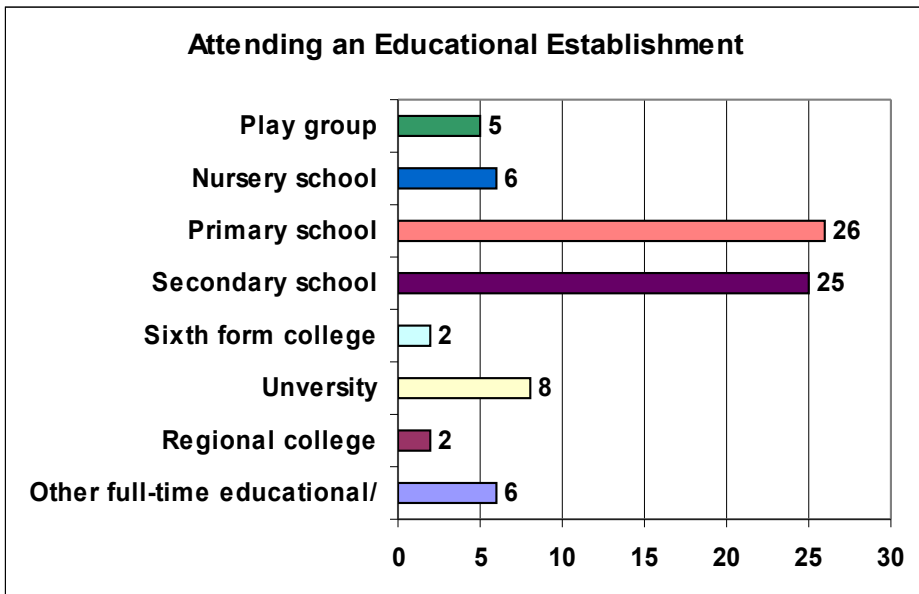

Q1 *Please enter the number of people in your household in each age group.*

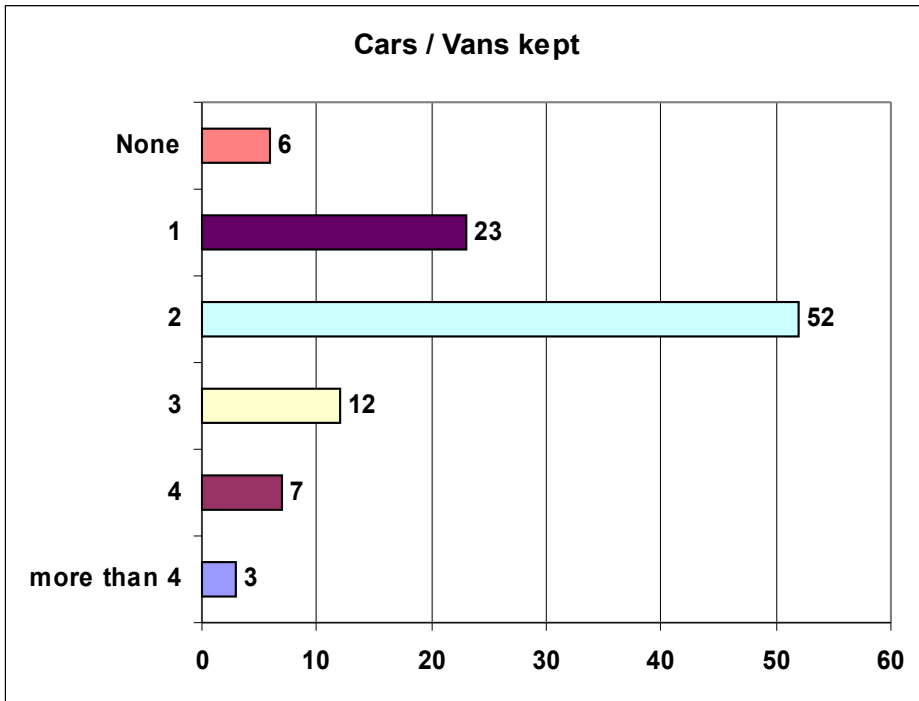


Q2 *Please enter the number of people in your household who attend the following:*



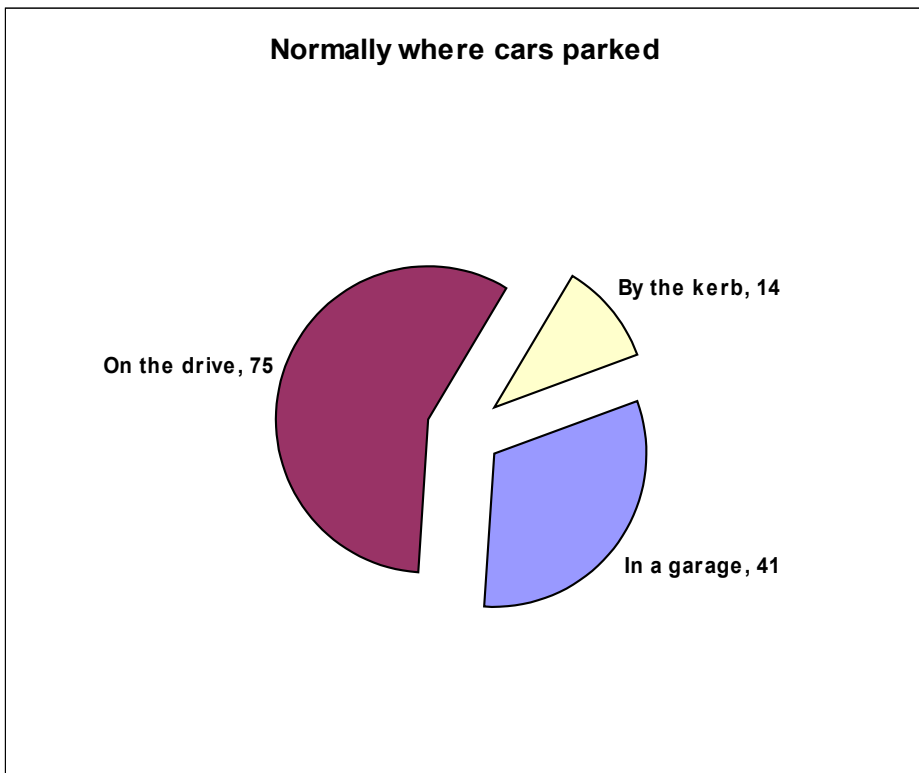

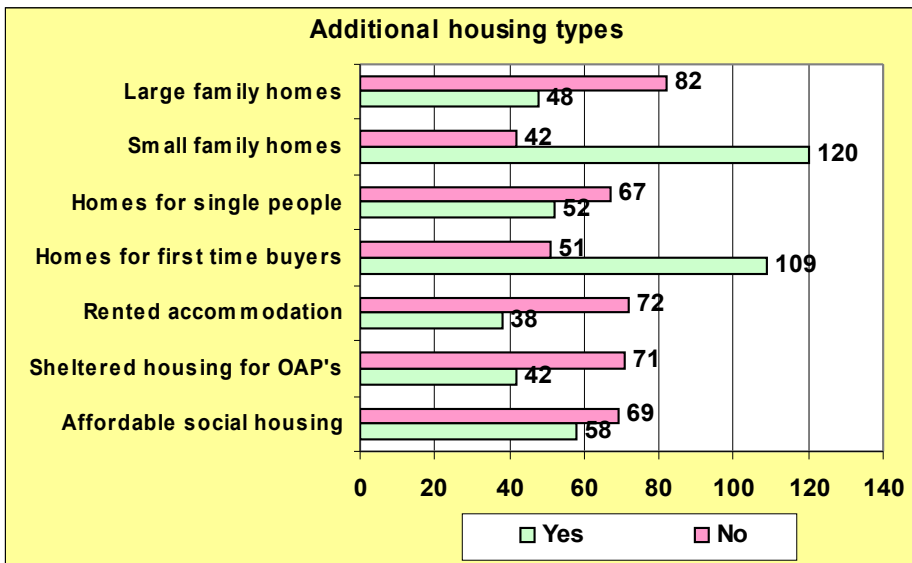

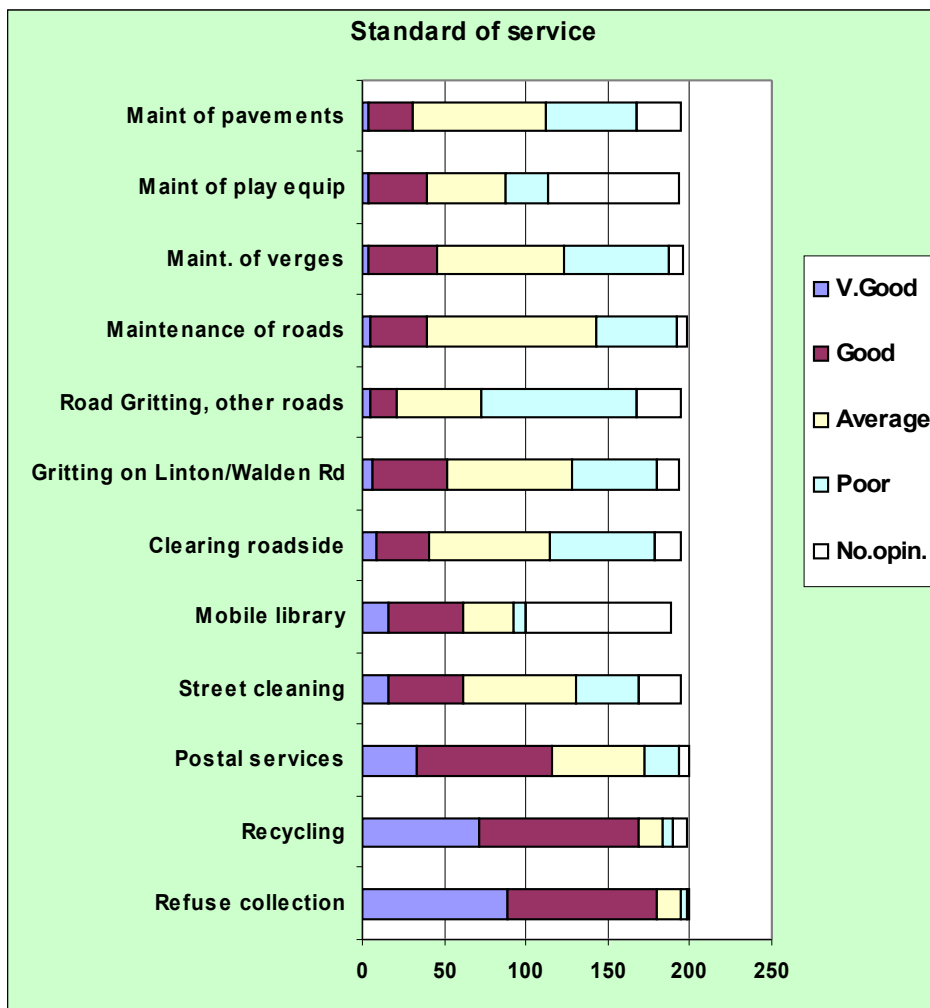

**Are you satisfied with the reception for the following telecommunications services?**



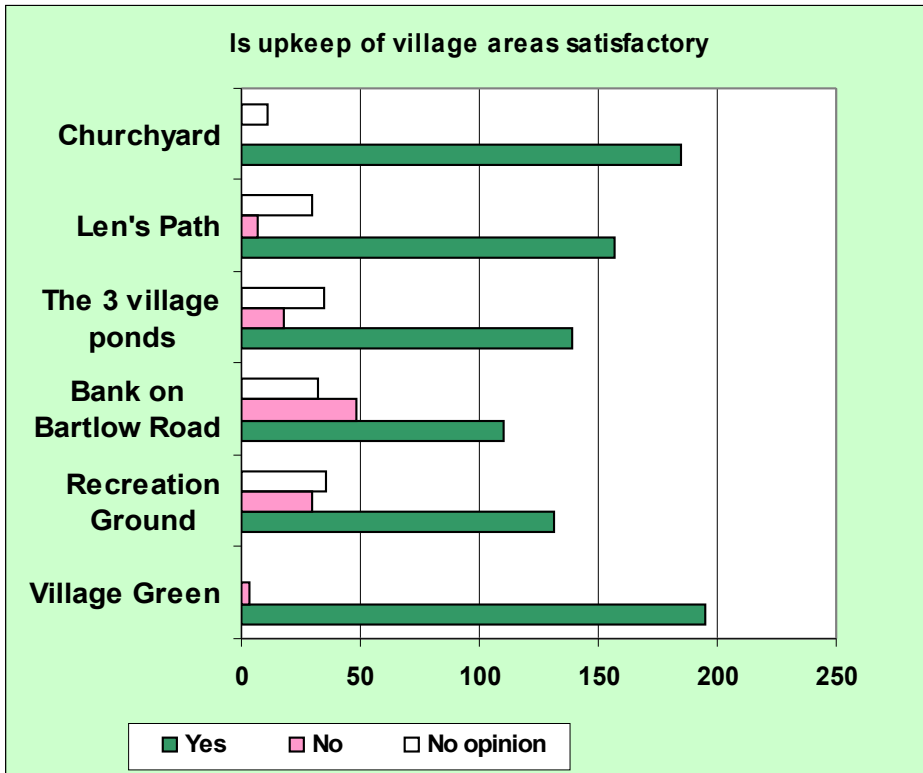

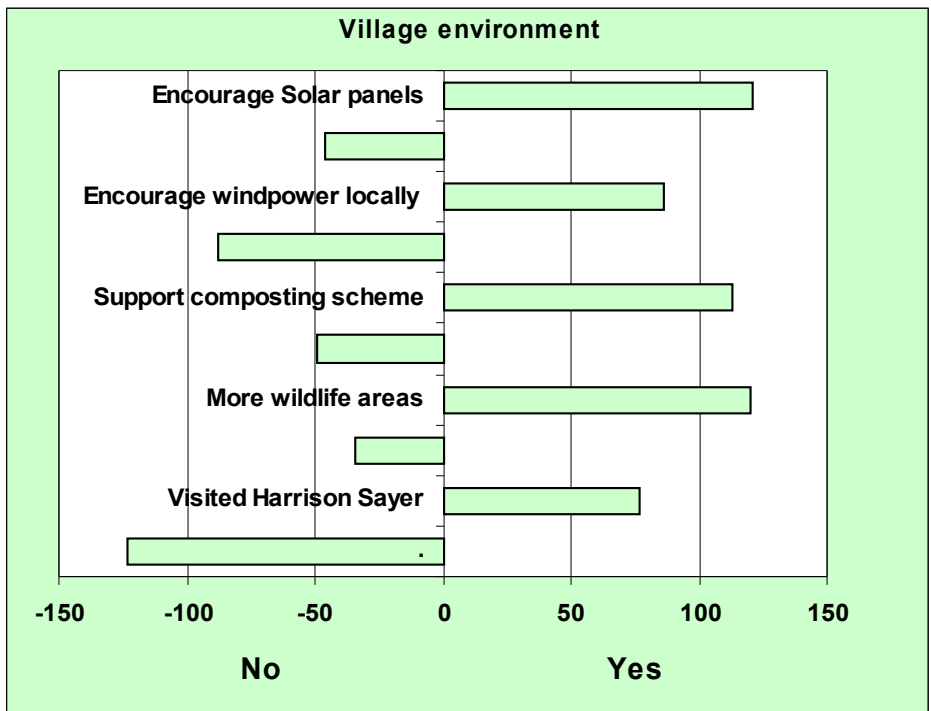

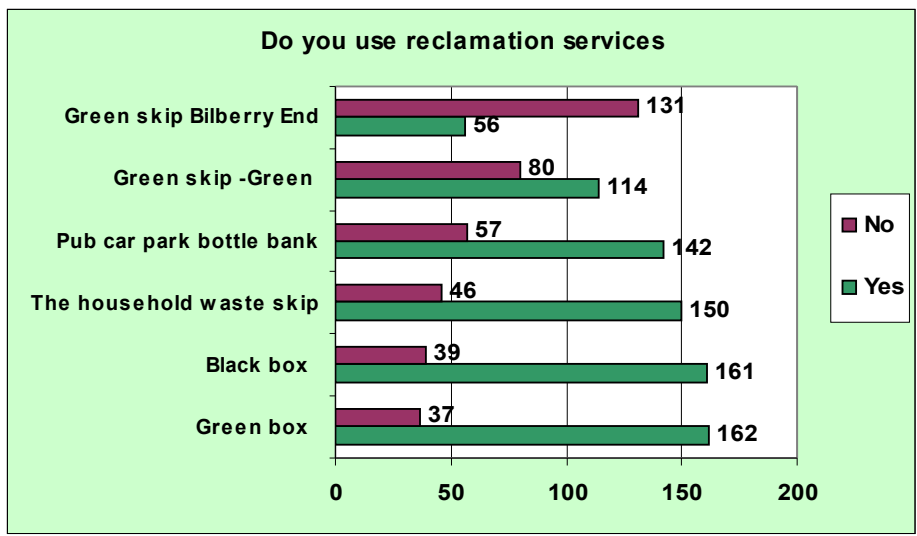

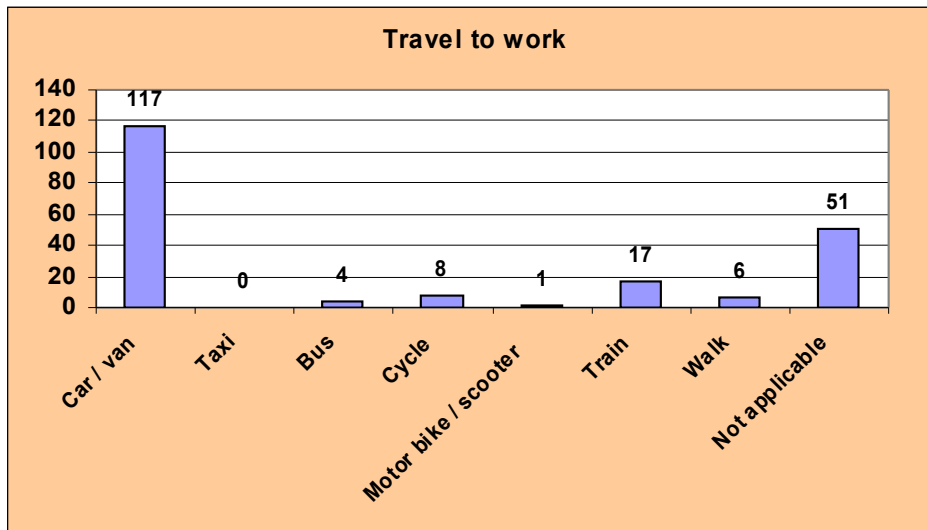

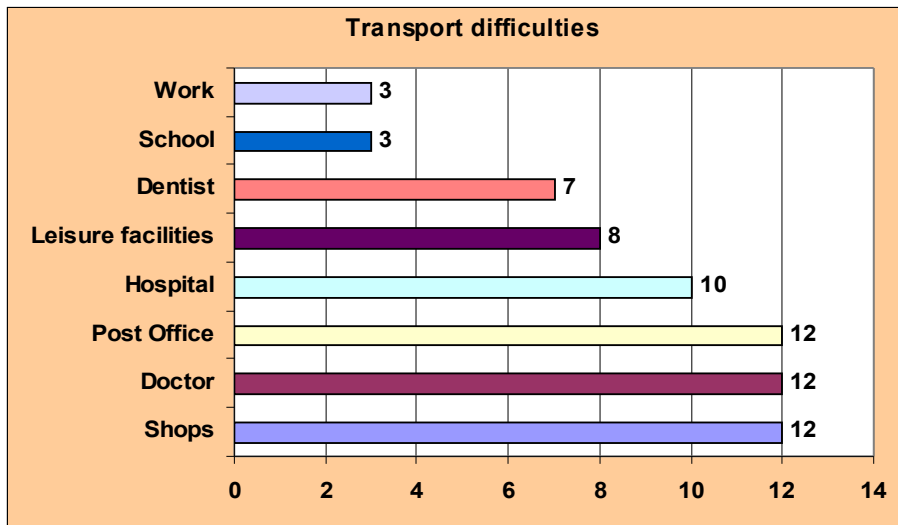

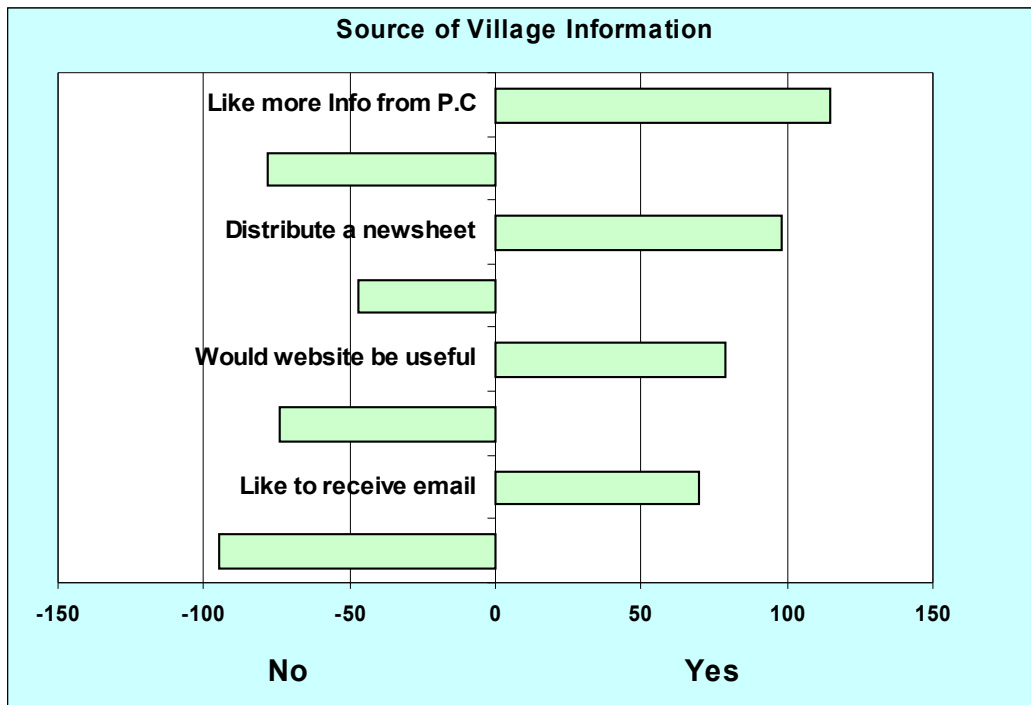
