Salt Bag Partnership Scheme for Winter 2017/18 has been launched!

Closing date is the 23rd July 2017

To support local communities to help themselves during periods of heavy snow and build on their community resilience, Essex County Council (ECC) would like to make available to each participating **Town** and **Parish Council** a one tonne wrapped pallet made up of individual 25kg bags for use by the community on the local highway. ECC is offering this free of charge again this year.

On the 23rd May we emailed all Town, Parish Councils asking if they wished to participate in the scheme in order that we can procure the volumes of salt needed and arrange delivery again for next winter.

To improve the scheme and reduce costs, we will continue using an Online application form to log all the details and are asking if you:

1. would like to participate and require salt, or
2. participate but have enough salt left due to the mild winter, or
3. Won't be taking part

Delivery Information:

If you are signing up and need salt, the delivery of the salt is programmed to arrive in September to early October to allow you time to allocate to your Volunteers. Please note we will not be making ad-hoc or additional re-stock deliveries throughout Winter.

The salt will be delivered by a large lorry (a bit bigger than a dustbin lorry) and the salt will be removed from the lorry via a tail lift and then moved on a trolley to its final destination. Please note that the trolley does not go over uneven or loose ground (grass, pebbles etc.) or steep inclines. The location you identify for delivery must be able to accommodate this.

About the Scheme:

If you are new to the scheme and would like to know how to set up the scheme for your area, the following points should be considered:

- Identify the priority areas for your local community (these must be on the public highway and not for any other area such as private driveways) such as footpaths outside local shops, doctors, access routes to main bus stops etc which are not *already* salted by ECC. The salting network is mapped on our

- Recruit volunteers in and around these areas – local businesses, nearby home owners, residents associations etc. Feedback indicates direct engagement is the most effective way to recruiting volunteers.
- Confirm that the volunteers are confident they are physically able to manually remove snow and then spread a thin layer of salt when required and provide them with Snow Clearance Guidance and Manual Handling information.
- Keep a record of these priority areas and the details of the volunteers who are nominated to clear snow/salt for each chosen location.
- Give each volunteer a bag/supply of salt to store in preparation for when it snows.

If it is your preference to produce your own you may, just simply run whatever version is decided upon through your insurers for Public and Employee Liability purposes. The pack contains:

- **A Volunteer Briefing Sheet – Snow Clearing Guidance** for your volunteers on how to clear snow and some things they should consider for their own safety and security.
- **A Winter Plan** – To set out details of your scheme, put on noticeboards or parish website (if you have one) and **A Risk Assessment form** - for the volunteer to complete with the Town or Parish Council.

Planning News

Minerals and Waste Policy planning

Examination of the Essex and Southend-on-Sea **Replacement Waste Local Plan** has been underway since June 2016. The hearing sessions began on Tuesday 27 September and adjourned on 7 October. As part of the examination process, the Planning Inspector has requested that a number of modifications be made in order for the Plan to be found sound and consequently suitable for adoption.

Public consultation on the **Schedule of Modifications** closed on 16 February 2017 with more than 550 comments received from around 370 individuals and organisations. All comments have been processed and were passed to the Inspector on Monday 20 March 2017. If you wish to view the comments received these are available to view now on the website www.essex.gov.uk/wlp. The Inspector is currently considering the comments received as part of the preparation of her final report. This is anticipated to be finalised in the coming weeks, and, if deemed sound, the Plan will be considered for adoption by the Authorities later in the summer.

Flood and Water Management

Essex County Council's Flood and Water Management Team recently carried out a **ditch clearance event in Saffron Walden**.

The suspect watercourse was overgrown and in places the cross section had been severely diminished. In times of high flow the usually dry ditch had been known to flood up and over its banks and into the bounding gardens. Within hours of attending, the team had cleared the offending vegetation and improved the channel profile so that the water could flow freely into a culvert at the end of the ditch.

The residents can now benefit from knowing the risk of flooding is reduced. Watercourse maintenance is in most cases the responsibility of the landowner. These events occur where exceptional circumstances prevent the landowners from being able to maintain their watercourses.

Where Does Water Go project

The Flood and Water Management team are looking for interested parish/town councils to take part in their **Where Does Water Go project**.

The project aims to use local volunteers to record data regarding the location and condition of watercourses and related structures. Many parish/town councils have already completed the project including: South Woodham Ferrers, Sturmer, Thaxted, North Fambridge, Halstead. Even more are currently going through the process, such as Radwinter, Great Bromley and Great Baddow.

The more parishes/town councils that complete this project the more comprehensive the whole map of Essex watercourses can become, giving the council valuable data which can be used to make informed decisions about development and flooding issues in your local area.
